

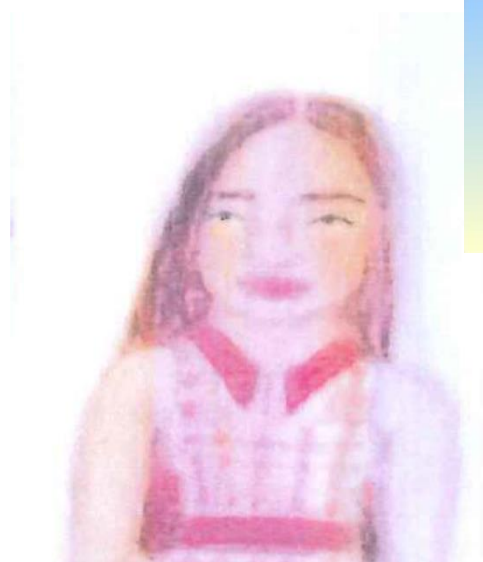
Councillor Co-operate (by Titas in 6G)

Tony tried to share his idea again. “Why don’t we build a hut before the thunder comes and we can shelter from the rain?”

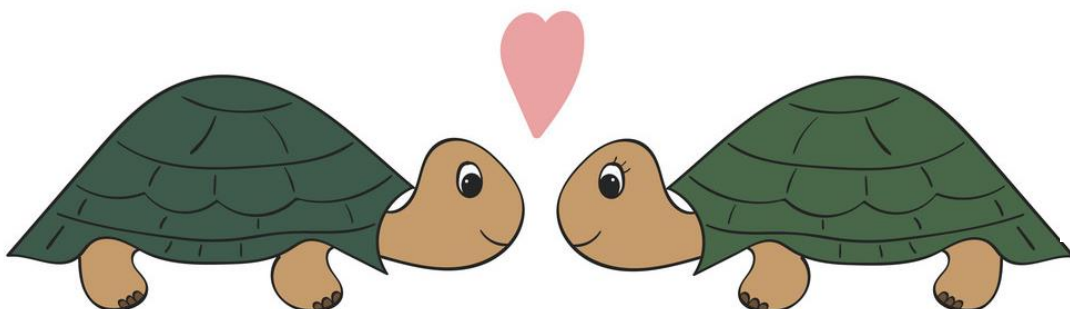
“I’ve already tried, and I can’t do it.” Tilly sobbed back.
