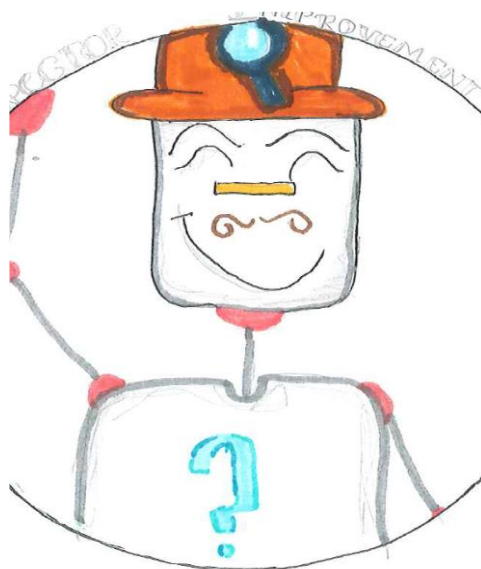


Inspector Improvement (by Ayman in 6G)
