SNAP MAP

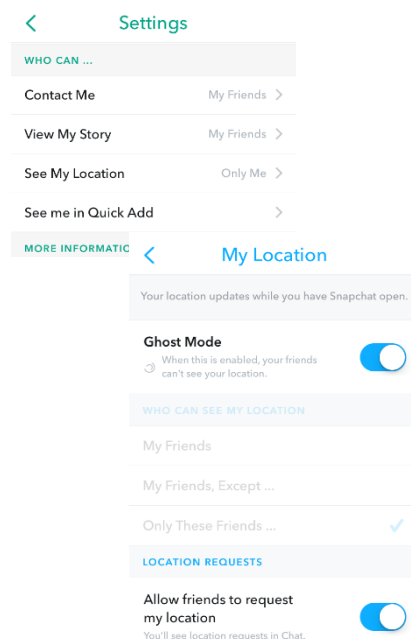


Everything you need to know.

Did you know that on Snap Maps, anyone can access your location?

To stop this from happening, go to Snapchat settings and click on 'only friends can see my location'.

All of your friends' names will come up and you can select the people who you want to see your location. If you do not want anybody to see where you are, you can turn ghost mode on.
