Logging in on Tablets or Smart Phones

If you are using Google Classroom on a tablet or a smart phone, you will find it easier to use if you download the Google Classroom app. Follow the instructions below to get started. All of the apps listed are official Google apps and are completely free to download and use.

Get the Classroom app

Students can use the Classroom app on Android and iOS mobile devices. The Classroom app is not currently available for Windows mobile devices.

Install the Classroom app on Android

Your device must have Android 4.4 KitKat or later to get the latest version of the Classroom app.

1. On your device, tap Play Store .
2. Find and install the Google Classroom app.

Install the Classroom app on iPhone or iPad

Your device must have iOS 11 or later to get the latest version of the Classroom app.

1. On your device, tap App Store .
2. Find and install the Google Classroom app.

Download the additional apps

To use all the features of the Classroom app, you need Google Docs, Sheets, and Slides. To create or join class video meetings, we recommend that you install the Google Meet app. If they aren't already on your device, you can get them from Google Play (Android) or the Apple App Store (iOS).

Using an Amazon tablet?

Because Amazon and Google are rival companies, the Google Classroom app is not in the Amazon app store. It is possible to install the app, but you would have to bypass some of the system security settings and we would not recommend this.

Instead, we recommend that you use the 'Silk Browser' which is the Amazon version of Google Chrome for

accessing the web. This has a swirly circular icon which looks a bit like a marble. See here:



Open the Silk Browser app, then go to <https://classroom.google.com>

It should take you to the classroom page, but it might take you a different page first. If it does, click on the 'Go to Classroom' button.

Your child should be able to help you log them in at this stage, having had lessons on it in school. If they or you are unsure, google have a tutorial here:

If your child has their own tablet, you should be safe to save their login details to the browser.
