

# Year 2 Home Learning Ideas

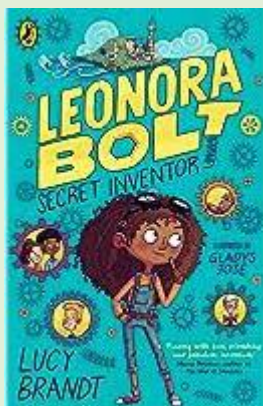
## Autumn B 2025

### Be an Author...

We will be reading 'Leonora Bolt: secret Inventor' by Lucy Brandt

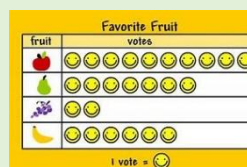


- Read another book by Lucy Brandt.
- Write about something you would invent.

### Be a Mathematician...

We will be learning how to measure objects using rulers, metre sticks and tape measures. Then we will be learning how to represent and understand pictograms, block diagrams, tables and tally charts. Finally, we will be working on multiplication and division.

- Practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- Make a Tally chart and ask your family what is their favourite fruit. Then make a pictogram.
- Measure some objects around your house in centimetres (cm). Which is the longest? Which is the shortest?



### Be a Geographer...

We are learning all about the countries that make up the UK as well as cities, rivers and mountains. We will be finding out about the seven continents of the world and learning about the different weather in these places.



- Find out about some landmarks that are in each country in the UK.
- Ask your family which country they have visited. Find out which continent it is on.

### Be an Artist...

We are making 3D boat models using paper mâché. We start by drawing with charcoal and then create colourful boats using cardboard, paint and collage.



- Can you use a crayon or pencil to make some rubbings of different surfaces?
- Can you make a collage picture of a boat using different materials?
