These optional Home Learning ideas are linked to the learning areas covered this half term.

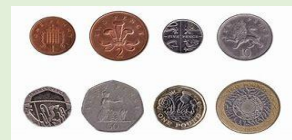
### Be brilliant in Phonics and Reading

- Read the alien and real word list daily.
- Learn phase 2,3 and 5 sounds from the sound mats provided and write words or sentences relating to the picture on the sound mat.
- Play Phonics Play 'Buried Treasure' or 'Pick a Picture'.
- Play phonic games on Topmarks.
- Learn to read and write the high frequency words from the list provided.
- Visit the library weekly to explore different genre of books.
- Read signs and labels in the environment (restaurant, shops, library or airport).
- Reading books to be read daily.
- Parents to read library books to their child to promote reading for pleasure.



### Be a Mathematician

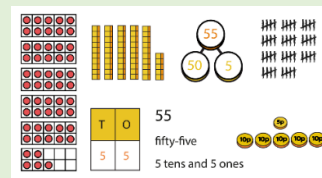
- Name coins and notes and understand their value.
- Match amounts to prices on items of shopping.
- Represent the same value using different coins.
- Calculate and represent change from amounts to £1.



- Investigate number bonds within 20.  
E.g:

$$11 + 1 = 12 \quad 10 + 2 = 12 \quad 9 + 3 = 12 \quad 8 + 4 = 12$$

- Read, write and represent numbers to 100.

### Be a Scientist...

- Identify and name trees in the park. Write about some of the trees characteristics e.g an oak tree produces acorns in the Autumn.
- Make a map of the park to show where different trees and plants can be found.
- Make rubbings of different tree trunks.
- Collect different leaves and make observational drawings of them.
