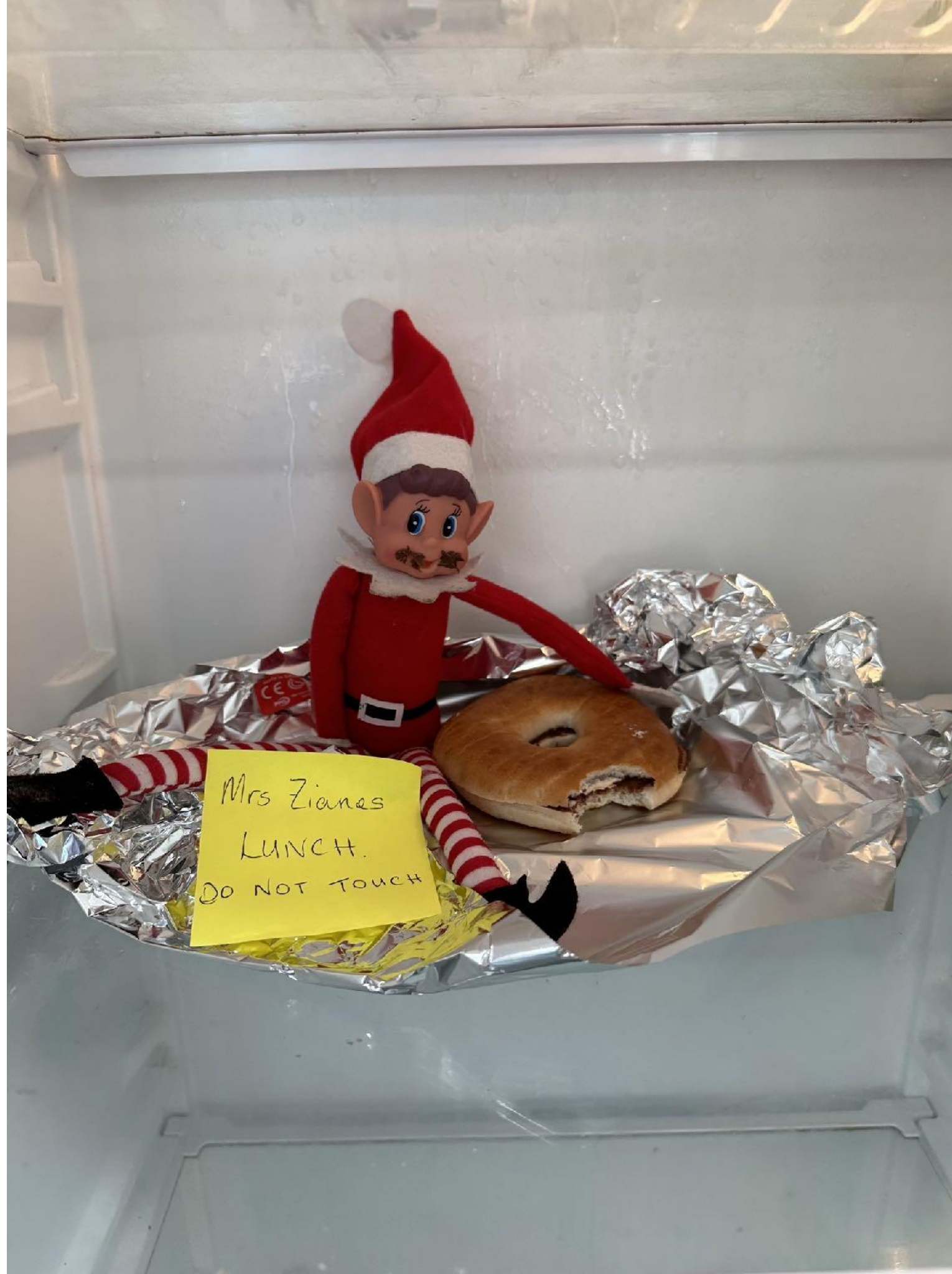


Naughty Elf - 19/12

lunch time.

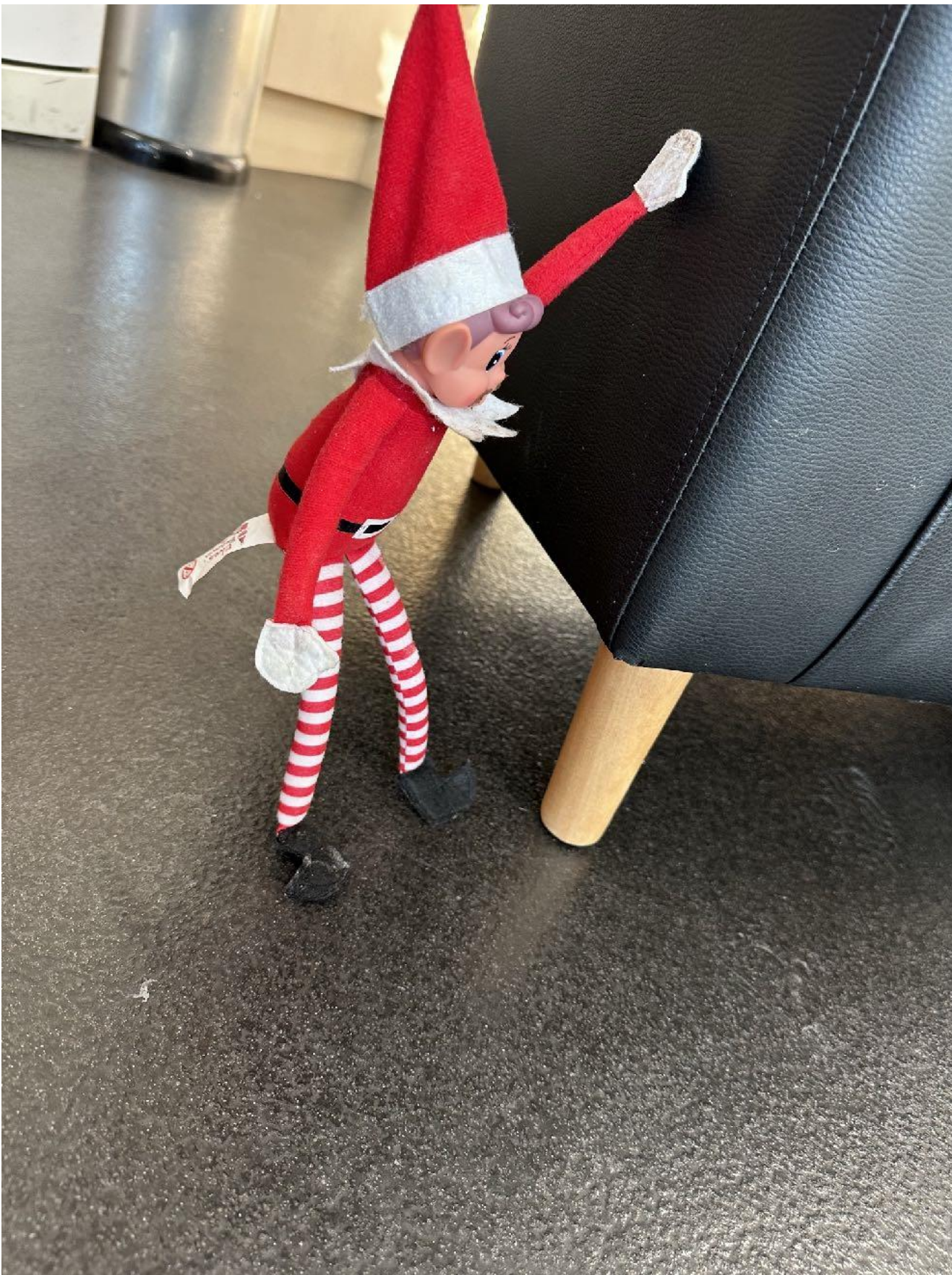
I tried to catch him, but he jumped out of the fridge with the visitors' milk and began to pour the milk down the sink. He was so fast I could not stop him.
