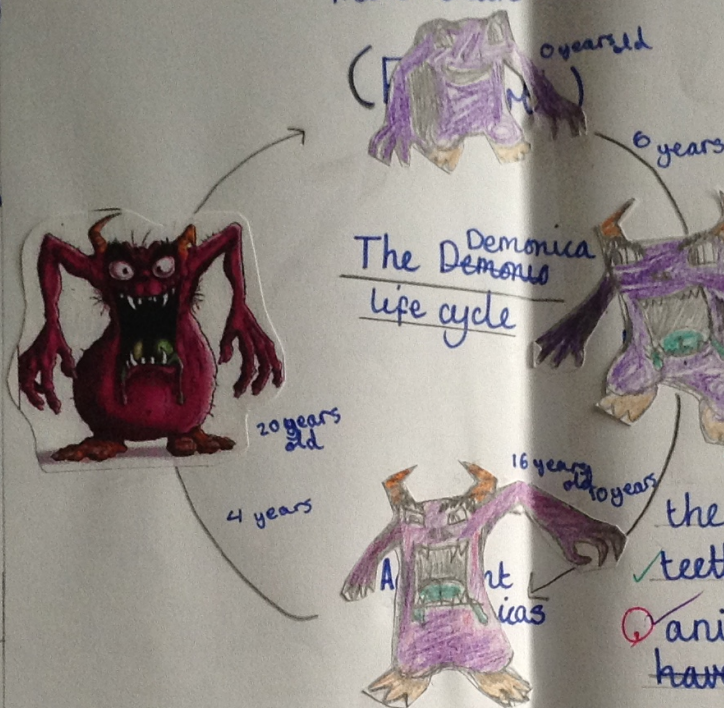

And if they struggle to survive, they get additional help - the baby will be trained more than the others. After 6 years, they grow into the young demonlet.

During Winter, the young demonlets hibernates with its family, while the father collects food for them and the mother builds or upgrades the shelter. What do the children do? They train with each other outside the shelter. The young demonlets grow in their teeth and horns, so they hunt smaller, nearby animals. Although they have just grown in, they have ~~j~~ are fairly strong, which goes well with their body strength.

As the young demonlets grow into the adolescent (teenaged) demonlets, they grow extra limbs (in the mouth, to stretch further) and get night vision. Now that they have extra weapons/powers, they are tested to get food for the family (all alone).
