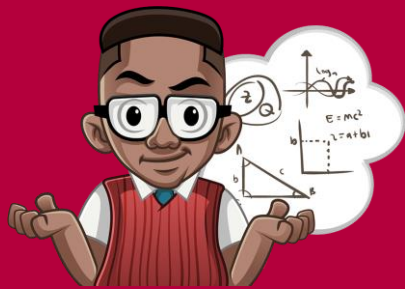


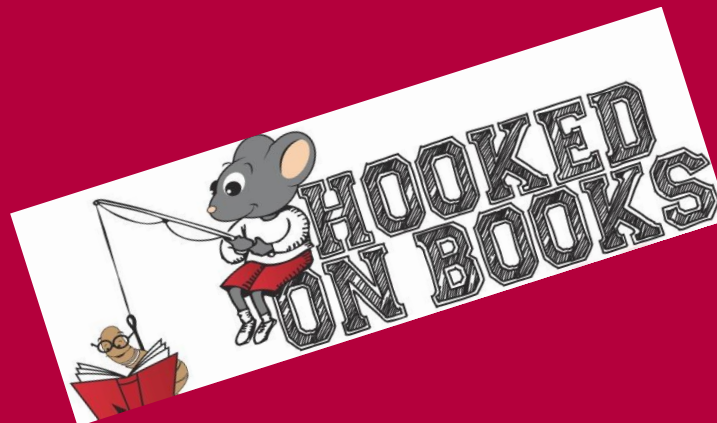

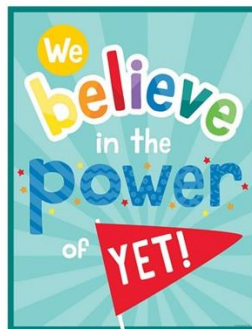

2D - Nicholas



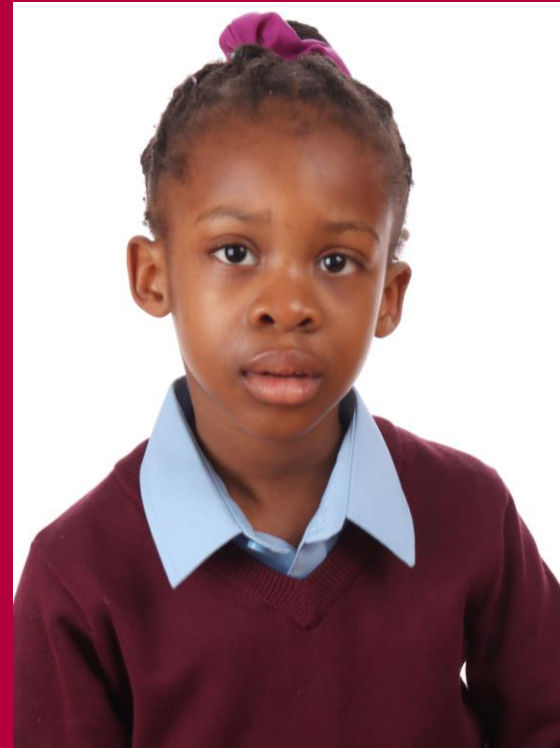
Awarded for improving his writing by adding more description and adjectives.

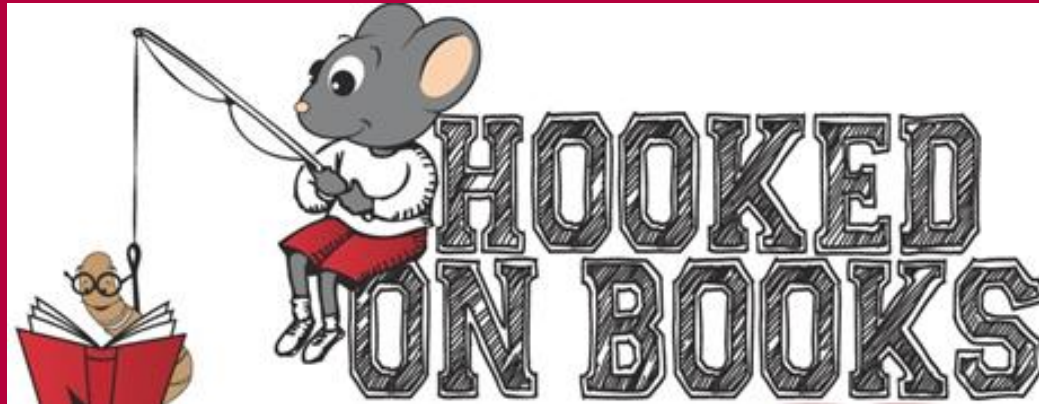

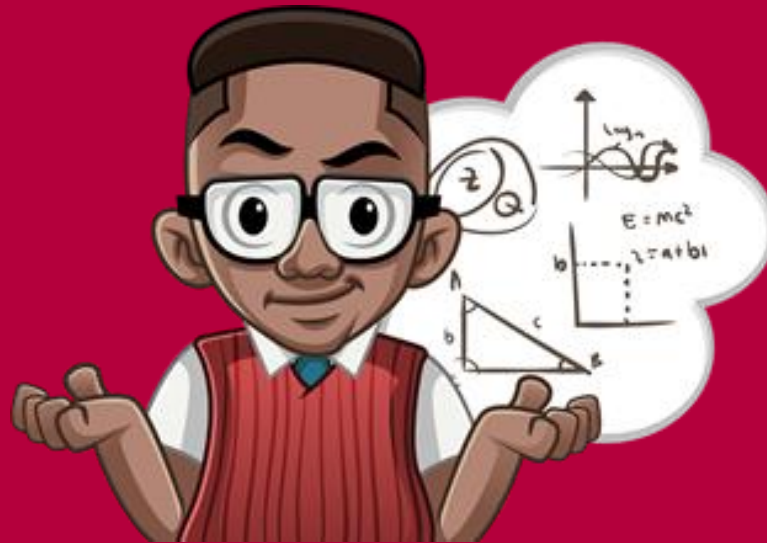

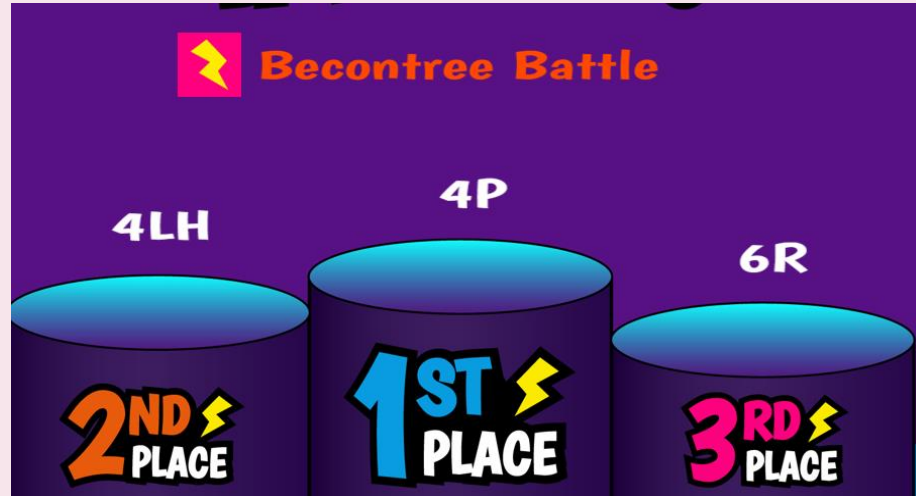
