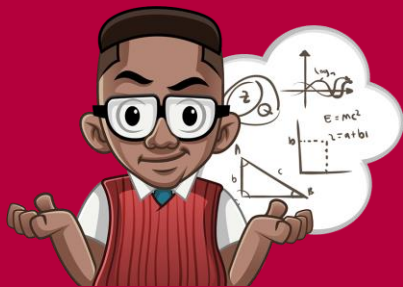


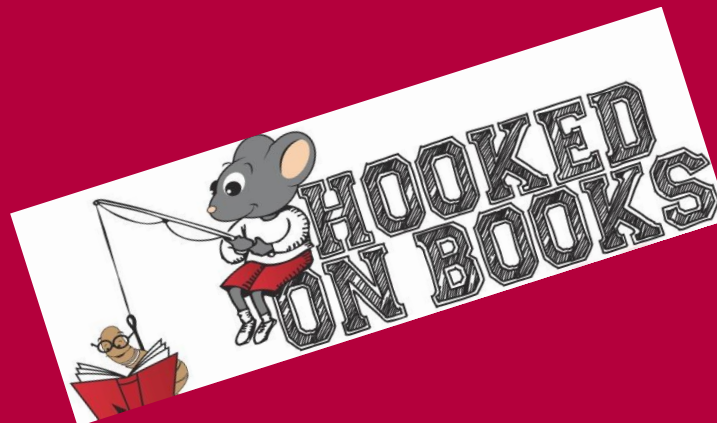

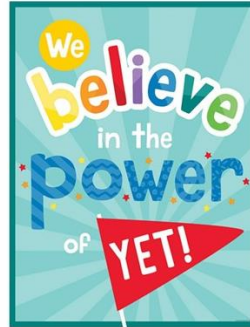

Our weekly awards assembly covers the following rights from the UN convention:

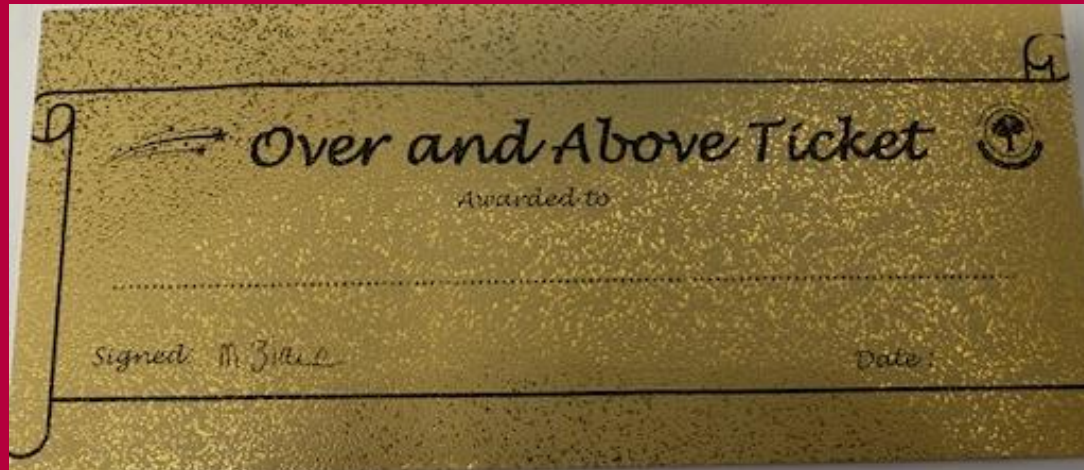
Article 2 (non discrimination)

The convention applies to every child without discrimination, whatever their ethnicity, sex, religion, language, abilities or any other status.

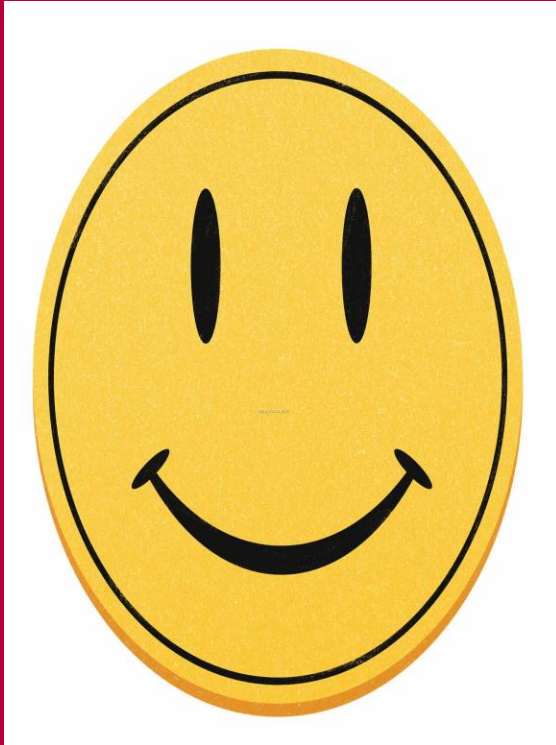
Article 29 (goals of education)

Awarded for being more engaged in class and trying his best with his learning.

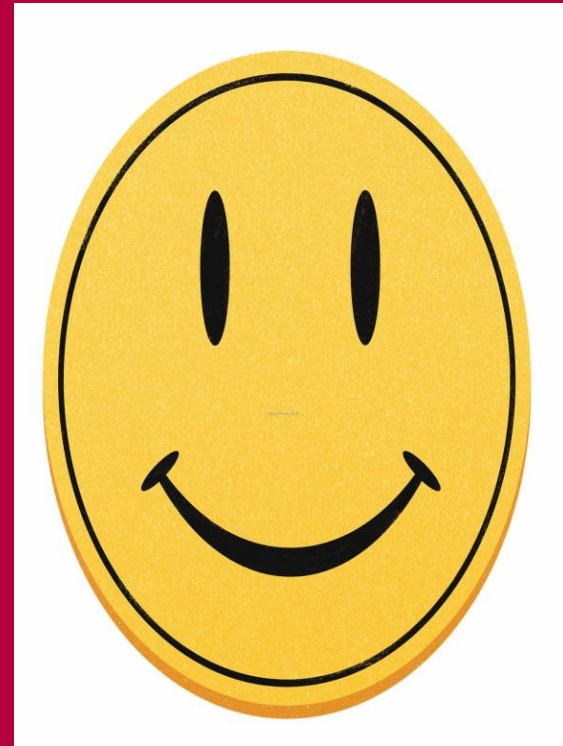

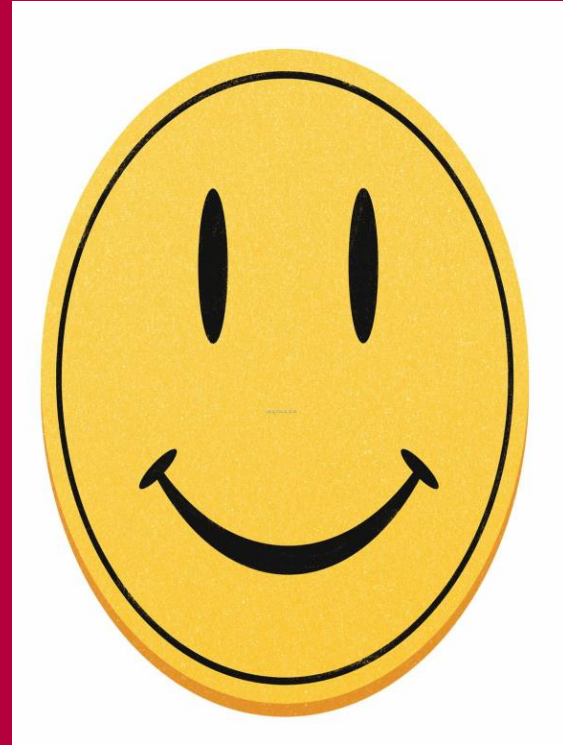
Awarded for doing his best and showing improvement in phonics and sentence structure while in 1H.

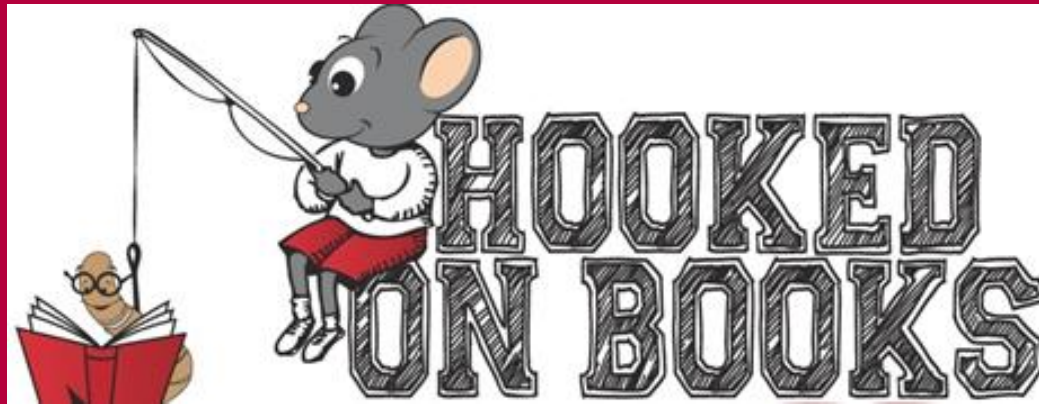

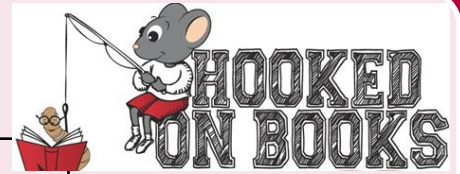

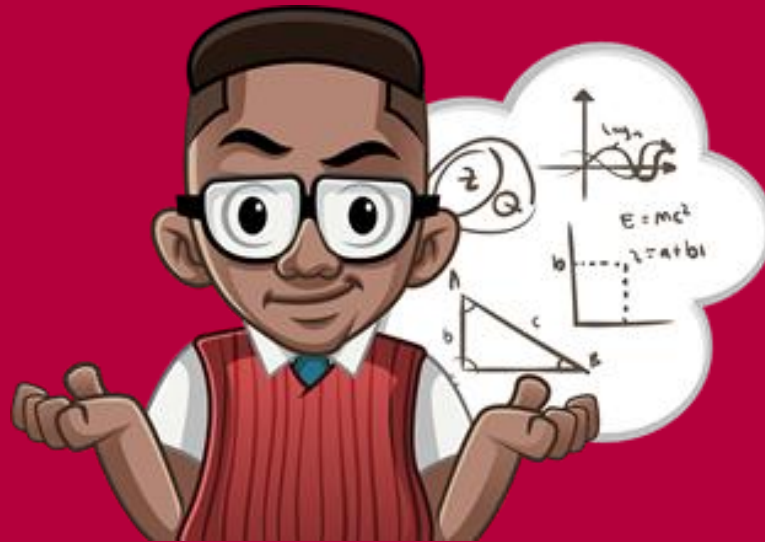
