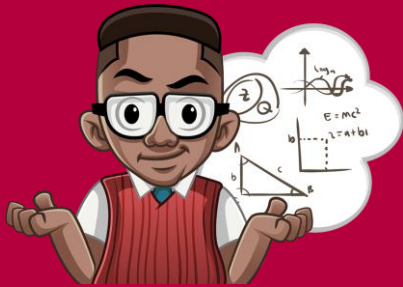


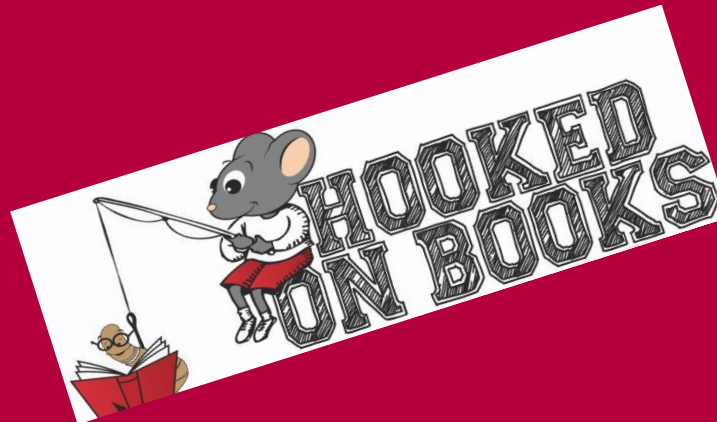

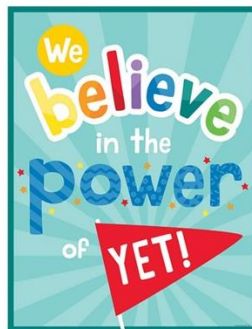

5L



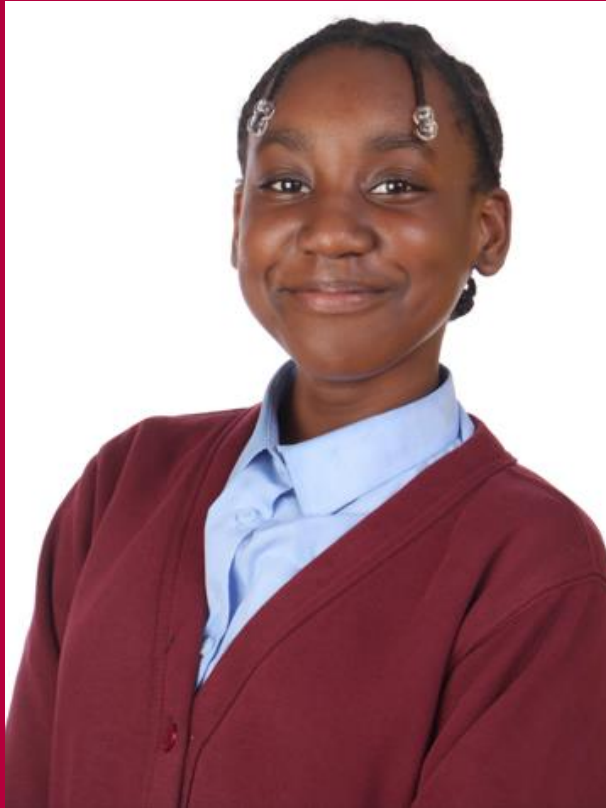
Awarded for dedicating her time to helping out her peers as well as adults.

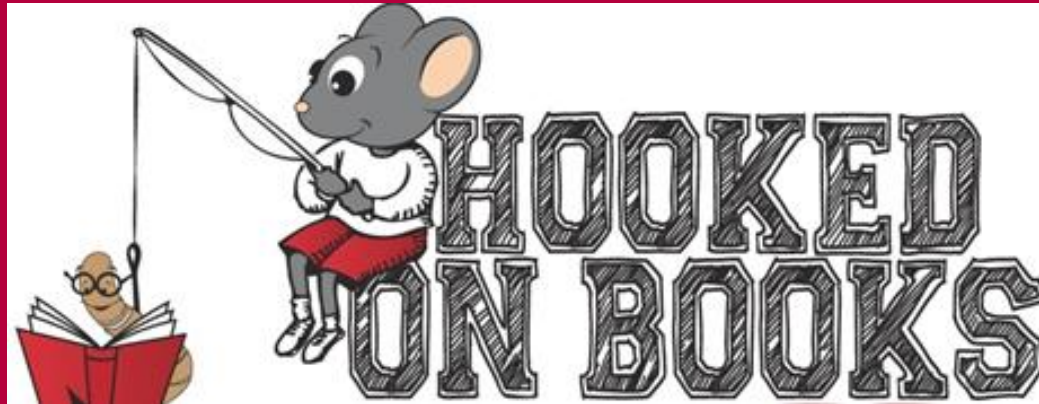

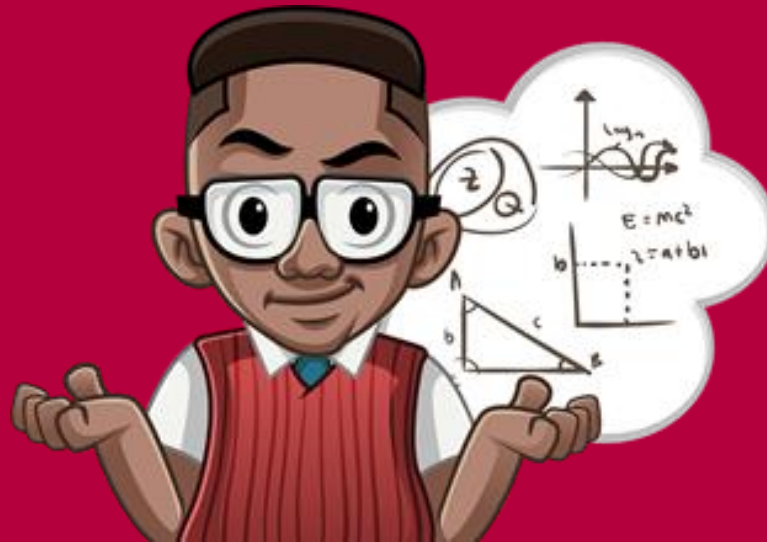

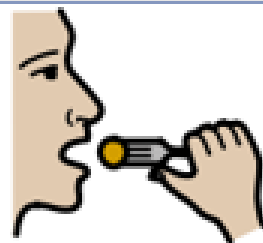
