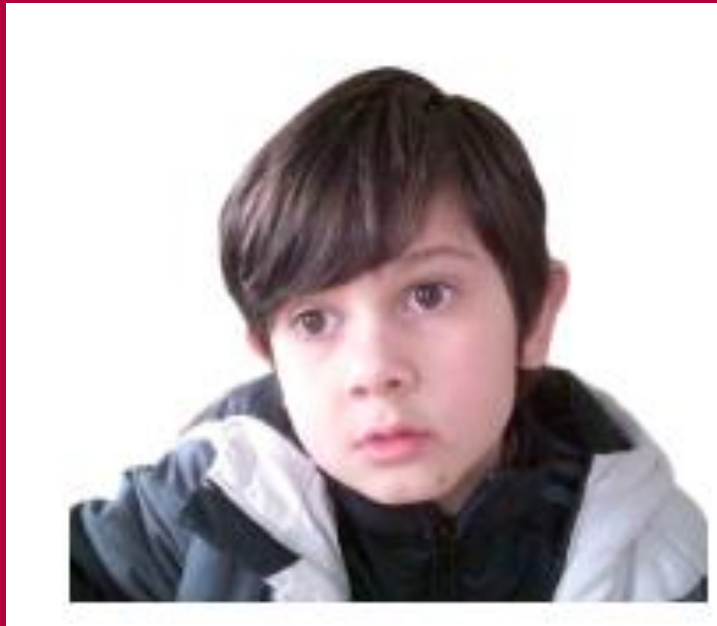
Awarded for always contributing to class discussions and trying hard to be respectful and wait his turn.

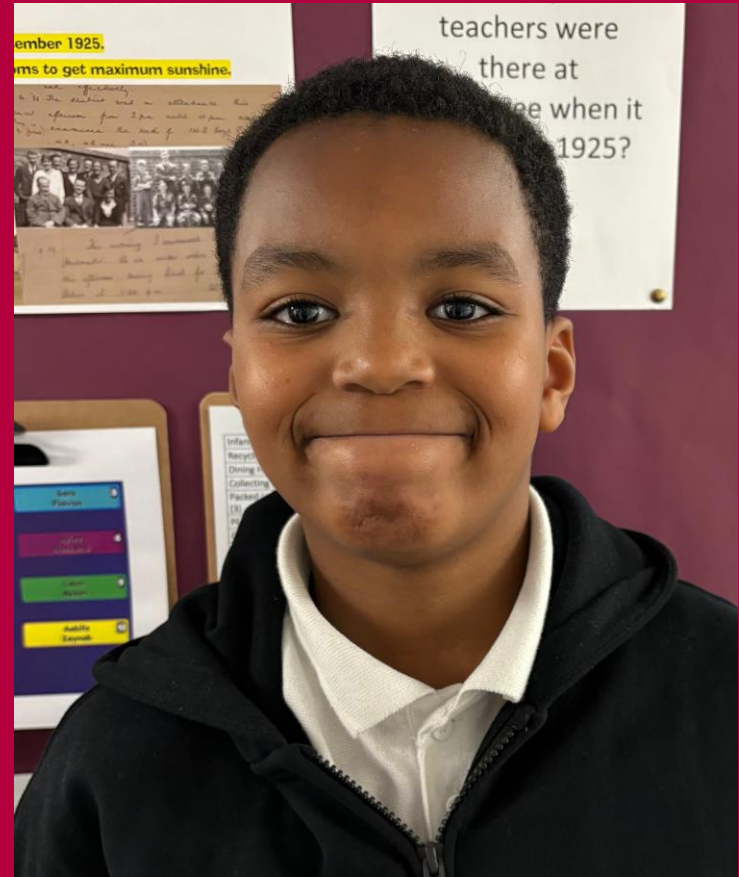
Awarded for sharing his knowledge about the ancient Greeks and conducting his own research outside of school.

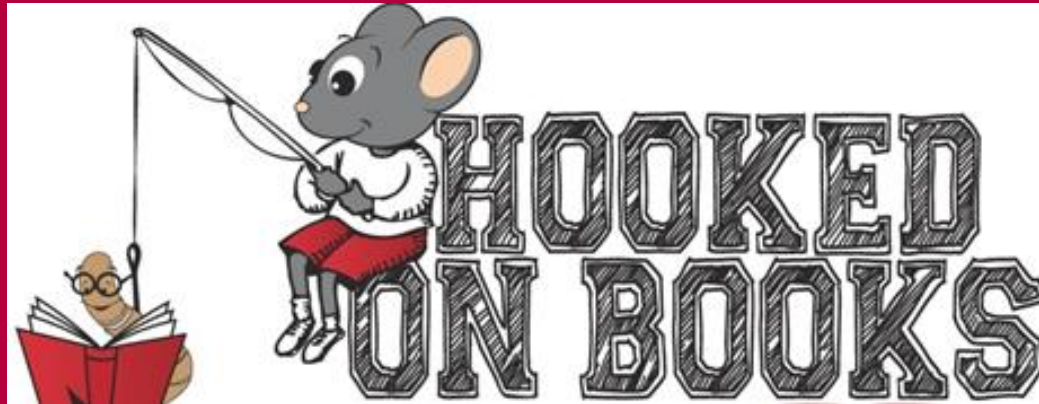

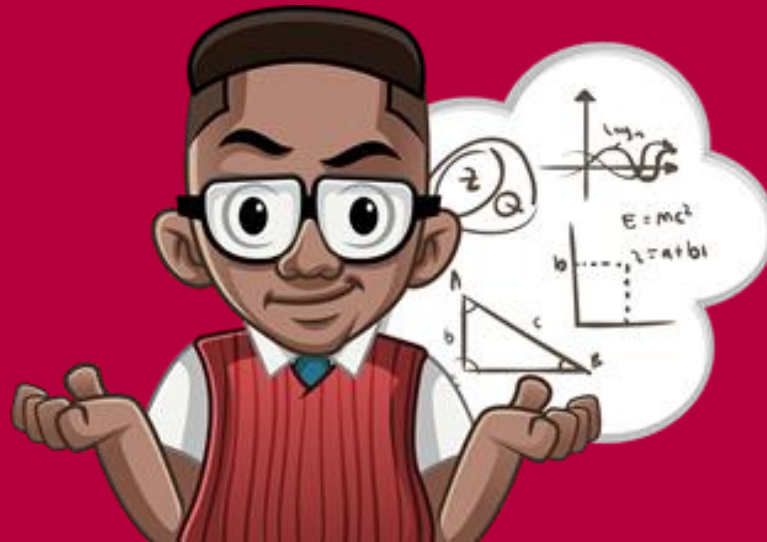
