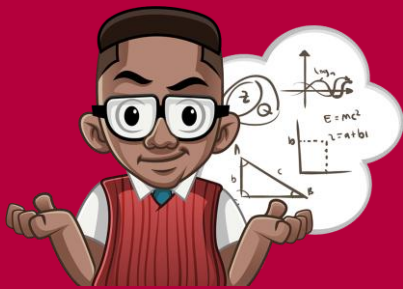


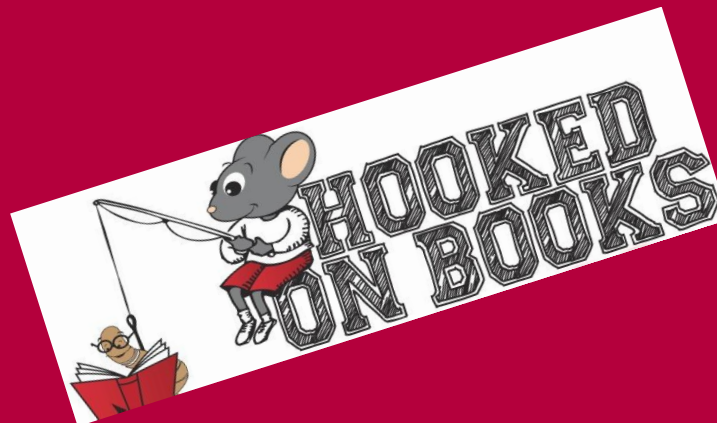

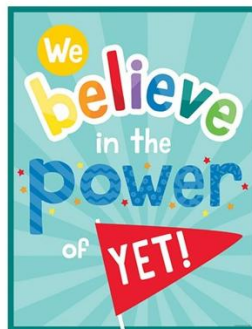

Awarded for showing respect to others through her actions.

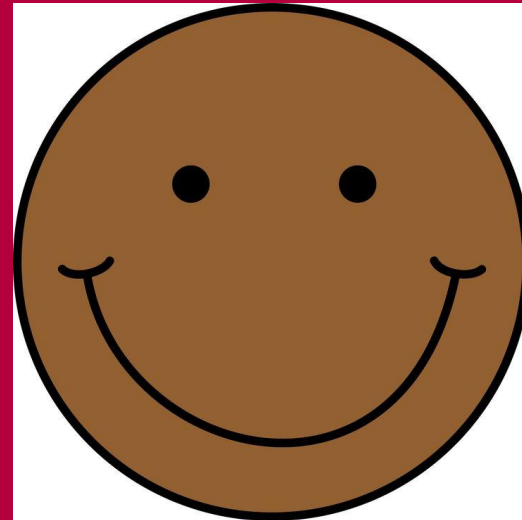


Awarded for being a great learning partner by listening, sharing and working collaboratively with his partner.

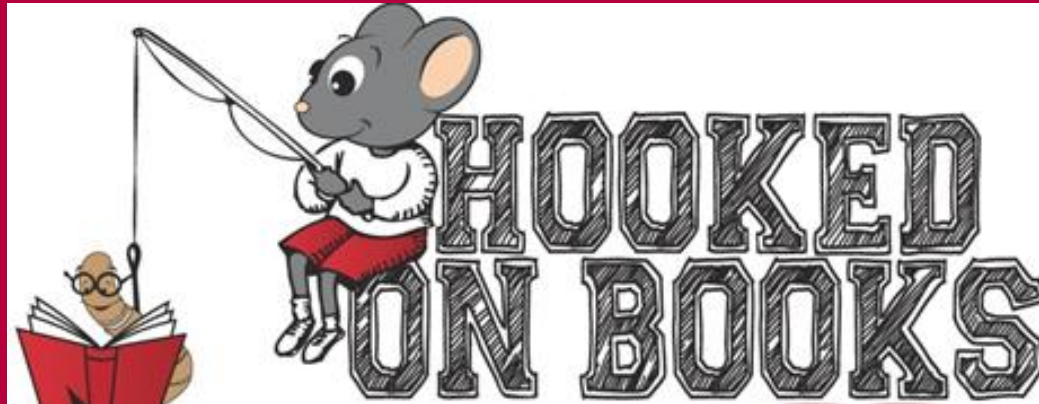

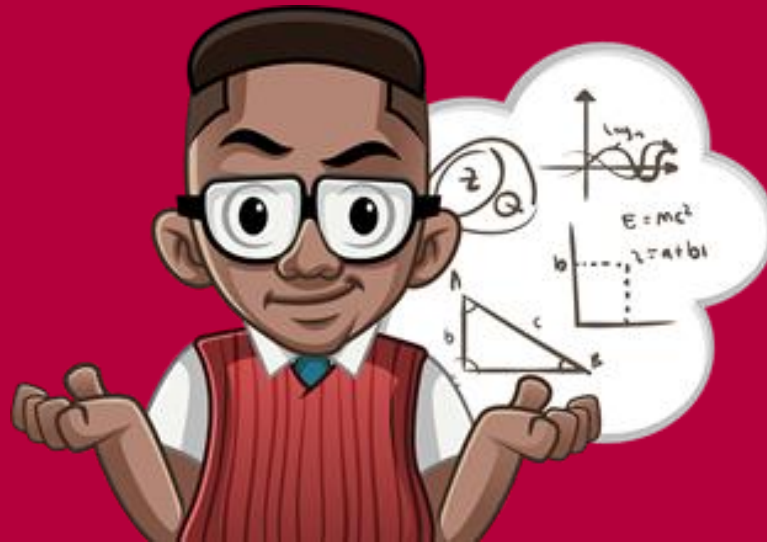
