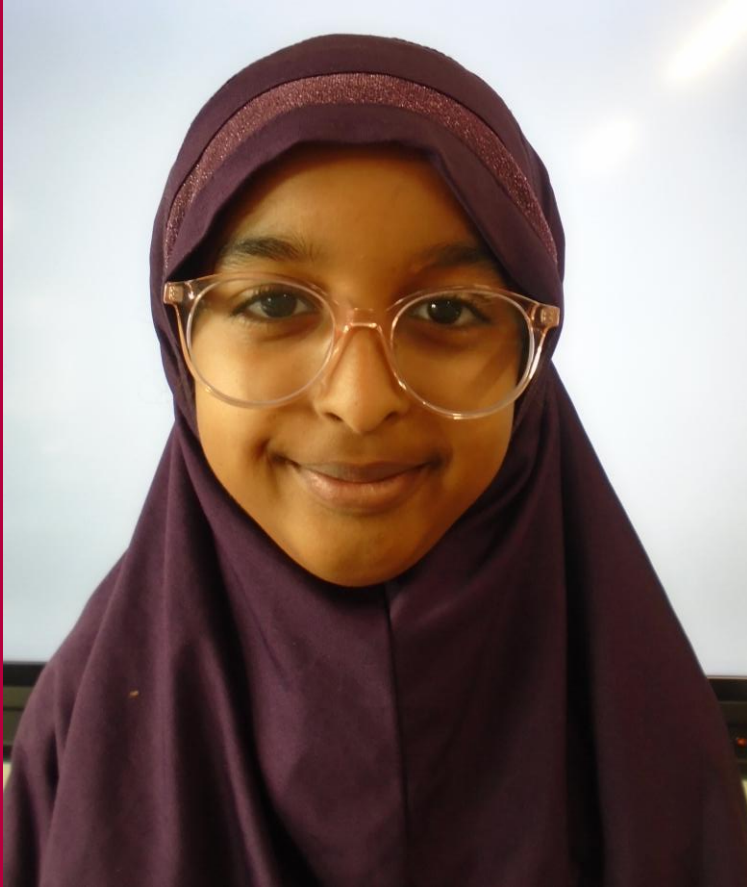
Awarded for making positive choices about how to conducting himself in the classroom, playground and around school.

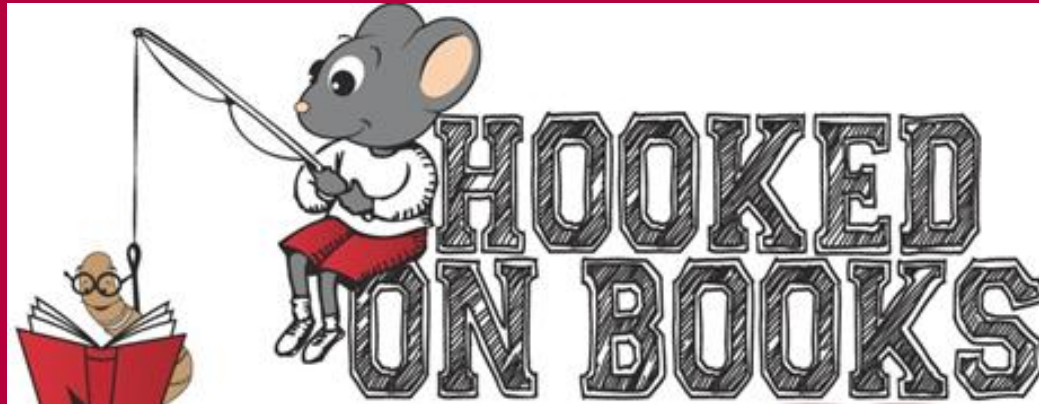

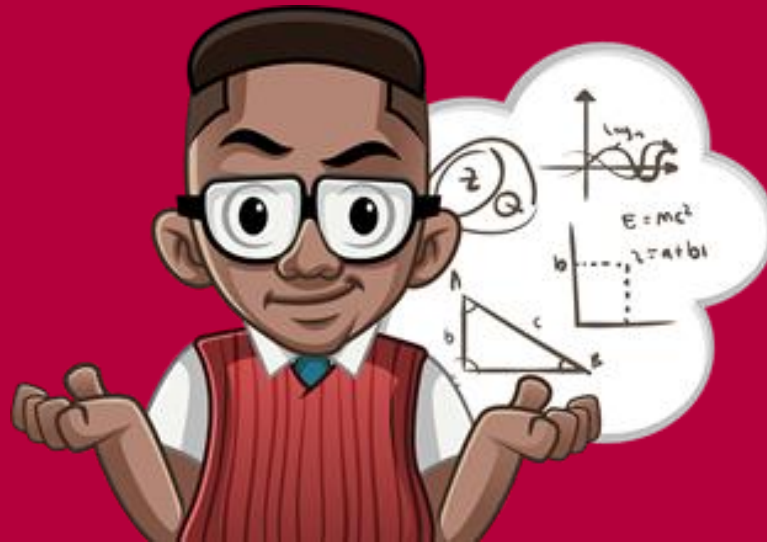
