Key home learning all Reception children are expected to do, includes:

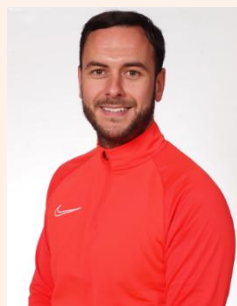
- **Regular communication/conversations** with your child to promote their oracy skills.

Speak to the class teacher if you do not have online access at home so we can look at options to support your child.

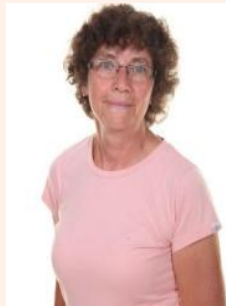

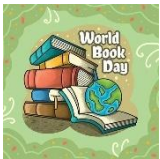
