Reception Expectations and Arrangements

Labelling Belongings: Please ensure **all** belongings and uniform are clearly labelled with your child's name.

Snacks: The children are provided with a piece of fruit each day at snack time. Children that are 4 years old are entitled to a carton milk until the term of their 5th birthday, when you can choose to continue paying for milk by completing a form from the school office.

Water: Please ensure your child has a labelled water bottle in school each day with unflavoured water only.

Book bags: Children will need to bring a **school bookbag** every day. As soon as they have a bag, we will begin sending them home with a book from our school library, which will be changed every week. Bookbags can be purchased from the Khalsa shop or via the link below:

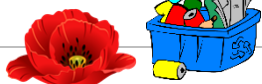
