

Writing statements for end of KS1 - Working AT the expected standard

Date										
-can write simple, coherent narratives about personal experiences and those of others (real or fictional) after discussion with the teacher										
-write about real events, recording these simply and clearly										
-demarcate most sentences in their writing with capital letters										
-demarcate most sentences in their writing with full stops										
-use question marks correctly when required										
-use present and past tense mostly correctly and consistently										
-use co-ordination (e.g. or / and / but) to join clauses										
-use some subordination (e.g. when / if / that / because) to join clauses										
-segment spoken words into phonemes and represent these by graphemes, spelling many correctly and										
-make phonically-plausible attempts at spelling unknown words										
-spell many common exception words*										
-form capital letters and digits of the correct size, orientation and relationship to one another and to lower-case letters										
-use spacing between words that reflects the size of the letters
