A 2-day Qualification covering:

- The role and responsibilities of the emergency paediatric first aider
- Use of first aid and protective equipment safely
- How to assess an emergency situation and prioritise your actions
- How to minimise risk of infection to self and others
- Completing an accident report/incident record
- How to recognise and help a baby or child who is:
 - unresponsive and breathing normally
 - unresponsive and not breathing normally
 - having a seizure; choking; bleeding
 - suffering from shock; suffering from anaphylaxis

This course also covers the requirements for the Emergency First Aid at Work qualification.
