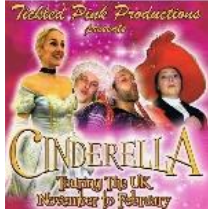




Christmas Arrangements 2025



Date and Time	Event	Information	
From Monday 1 st December	Naughty Elves	The Naughty Elves will be visiting the school. They usually get up to all kinds of mischief. Ask children to look out for them and to tell you about their daily activities.	
	Christmas Cards	Children may bring in Christmas cards for friends and staff. These will be handed out in class. Please help children with spelling of names and writing appropriate greetings, and ensure they put the child's name and class on the envelope.	
Monday 8 th December	Christmas-themed Movie Nights 3.15 p.m. – 5.00 p.m.	For children in Year 1 – Year 6. Tickets for children to attend this event are £3.00. The price includes a drink and a snack. Tickets can be purchased from the main office. The film will start at the end of the school day and children must be collected from the main office at 5.00 p.m.	
Tuesday 9 th December	Pantomime During school hours	A professional company, Tickled Pink, will be in school to perform Cinderella. We will be asking for a £3 contribution towards the cost of this event. <i>Children are invited to wear non-uniform on this day – this may be Cinderella themed or just festive.</i> First performance for Year 3-6, and a.m. Nursery in the morning. Second performance for Reception, Year 1-2, ARP, Zenden and p.m. Nursery in the afternoon.	
Thursday 11 th December	CMS Orchestral Performance 11.00 a.m.– 12.00 a.m.	Children in Years 3 – 6 will be watching a live Christmas orchestral performance by the Community Music Service during school hours. This event is free of charge as the school will be covering the cost.	
Monday 15 th December	Reindeer Run	All children in the ARP, EYFS and KS1 will decorate/create reindeer antlers. On the day, children will be asked to dress up as a reindeer, if they want to, and they will do a reindeer walk/run around the playground. There is no need to buy an outfit. Any non-uniform will do. Parents/Carers will be asked to make a small donation if they can, which will be donated to the Change4Change team fundraising pot for Save the Children Charity. Photographs of the event will be shared on the school website.

Children will be performing Christmas songs/EYFS nativity and parents are invited to join in. Tickets are free of charge but you will need one to attend the event. These can be collected from the school playground or office from the 1 st of December. Due to space, only two tickets per family are available, initially.	
Wednesday 17 th December	Performance Day 2 9.15 a.m onwards Year 3,4,5 Year 1 and 2, Nursery/Reception	Any tickets not collected by Wednesday 10 th December will be made available to anyone who would like more.	
Wednesday 17 th December	Christmas Fete 3.30 p.m. – 5.30 p.m.	All Parents/Carers are invited to join us for this Christmas themed fete. Tickets for Santa's grotto and the raffle will be available for purchase on Mondays and Tuesdays at the school gate. They can also be purchased from the school office.	
Thursday 18 th December	Christmas Jumper Day	Children and adults are asked to wear Christmas jumpers to school. Any non-uniform will also be acceptable if children do not have a Christmas jumper. Any small donations for 'Save the Children' will be collected by the Change4Change group.	
	Christmas Lunch	Many children who have a packed lunch for the rest of the year choose to have a Christmas dinner on this day. If you want your child to have a Christmas dinner, please ensure that you book it via School Grid. Christmas dinner for ALL children is FREE as usual.	
Friday 19 th December	Christmas Parties During school hours	Children may come to school wearing their party outfits or any non-uniform on this day. The school will supply a snack and drink – no food needs to be brought in from home.
